ONLINE HOME LEARNING

Pupils have been issued with a **Seesaw** login which will, once again for our older pupils, be used as our main vehicle for communicating learning expectations during this time. All pupils have a Microsoft login which enables them to join a Teams meeting and access 'live' sessions.

SCHOOL LUNCHES

- If you would like your child to have a school lunch, please book this in the usual way using Parentpay. These will be cold, packed lunches.
- If your child is entitled to a free-school meal (all pupils in years Reception, 1 and 2 and any other pupils eligible) then please ensure this is booked as usual.
- Pack ups will be provided for pupils eligible for free school meals NOT attending school. These can be collected from 11.30am daily from the school's reception. *Please note, these are for pupils eligible for pupil premium and NOT universal free-school meals.*

PUPILS ATTENDING SCHOOL

- Children should wear school uniform and MUST have indoor shoes. Please bring a PE kit/ sports clothing every day.
- Children will be encouraged to play on the field so we advise you bring wellies/ old shoes or trainers.
- Children will be working in small groups and will be following a very similar timetable to those pupils working online at home.
